MERITA is now cubed and wins the call European Platforms 2024

The **MERITA platform** has once again been selected among the winners of the **Creative Europe European Call 2024** with **co-funding from the European Union**, for a total of €2,800,000.

Built on the success of the MERITA platform, **MERITAcubed** will continue to promote and support emerging chamber music artists and cultural heritage across Europe.

MERITAcubed aims to foster a **sustainable and inclusive chamber music ecosystem**, with the following objectives:

- Supporting the careers of young talents through targeted training and professional development opportunities.
- Promoting online and offline networking among artists, cultural institutions, and the public.
- Developing a sustainable business model for the entire chamber music sector, from the artist to the audience.

From October 2025 to October 2029, MERITAcubed will support 56 ensembles, including string quartets and piano trios, through a series of concerts, showcases, artistic residencies, and much more, thanks to the collaboration of 19 partner organizations from 16 different European countries, with additional partners joining throughout the initiative.
